- Note – 125 LIVE sliding scale is updated each year after the updated federal poverty guidelines are released, typically each January.
- Updated rates will be applied to individual billing statements at that time.
- Tiers are based on 25%, 40%, 50% and 60% of annual and monthly fees.
- Annual table update – Tier one (starting point – both 1 person and 2 person) annual income is derived from the Federal Poverty table. Monthly income is 1/12 of annual income rounded up or down). Tier 2 upper range figures are calculated by taking 1.35% of Tier 1 annual and monthly figures, Tier 3 upper ranges are calculated by taking 1.40% of Tier 1, Tier 4 upper ranges are calculated by taking 1.45% of Tier 1).
- Cost per person is calculated as follows: Tier 1 = 25% of monthly and annual cost, Tier 2 = 40% of monthly and annual cost, Tier 3 = 50%, Tier 4 = 60%
